



Information on our Privacy policy, as per Italian State Decree 196 of 30 June 2003

As per Article 13 of the above-mentioned decree in relation to the protection of privacy and personal data, we wish to inform visitors to our site that all and any personal information freely supplied by visitors to it in order to use our services or site will be treated in such a manner as to ensure its safety and privacy, as required by the above-mentioned law, by STORCHI Az. According to the decree, personal data must be treated in a transparent, correct and legal manner that guarantees the privacy and rights of users. Article 7 of State Decree 196/2003 - Right to Access Personal Data and Other Rights

1. Interested parties shall have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him/her exists, regardless of their being already recorded, and communication of such data in intelligible form.
2. Interested parties shall have the right to be informed
 - a) of the source of the personal data;
 - b) of the purposes and methods of the processing;
 - c) of the logic applied to the processing, if the latter is carried out with the help of electronic means;
 - d) of the identification data concerning data controller, data processors and the representative designated as per Section 5(2); and e) of the entities or categories of entity to whom or which the personal data may be communicated and who or which may get to know said data in their capacity as designated representative(s) in the State's territory, data processor(s) or person(s) in charge of the processing.
3. Interested parties shall have the following rights:
 - a) to obtain updating, rectification or, where interested therein, integration of the data;
 - b) to obtain erasure, anonymization or blocking of data that have been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which they have been collected or subsequently processed;
 - c) to obtain certification to the effect that the operations as per letters a) and b) have been notified, as also related to their contents, to the entities to whom or which the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the right that is to be protected.
4. Interested parties shall have the right to object, in whole or in part,
 - a) on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even where they are relevant to the purpose of the collection;
 - b) to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, where it is carried out for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or else for the performance of market or commercial communication surveys.
